It is hard to believe that another year has passed and we are approaching year number five since a few Fallbrook High School Alumni gathered to form this Association...a group of former students wanting to "give back" to Fallbrook High. Each year has presented more opportunities to do just exactly that.

Beginning my second year as president, I made a personal goal for our association to be in a position to give \$1000 in scholarship money by the end of the school year. We did it...and more...starting off in the fall by supplying over 50 fully stocked backpacks to needy FHS students, a direct result of our "Backpack Buddy" program. Not only has this endeavor been very enthusiastically supported by our FHS Alumni, and the local business community has once again stepped up to the plate. Our student fund has grown to \$2515.55 thanks to some extremely generous former students and community business owners. We have even received an offer by one individual (who wishes to remain anonymous) to match dollar for dollar (up to \$500) any extra donations made to the Student Fund.

As a result, we gave three \$50 "Do The Right Thing" awards to deserving students for showing exemplary character. Often students face strong challenges, and have tough decisions to make. Doing the right thing is not always as easy as it looks. We have many outstanding young people attending Fallbrook High School, and the selection process was difficult.

During the Senior Awards Assembly at the end of the academic year, the Association proudly awarded three scholarships totaling \$1500. Based on need as well as academic achievement, these awards were presented: \$500 to Michelle Jilly who will attend Brooks Institute of Photography; \$500 to Jeanette Bradbury for the fine arts in both writing and graphic design. The third \$500 scholarship was given in memory of Patricia Klaviter Grevatt, to Robert Kabrel, who will be studying elementary education.

To those who did not know her, Pat Grevatt was one of the enthusiastic founders of the Fallbrook Alumni Association, an elementary school teacher, and a member of the FHS graduating class of 1957. Her dedication to students was a lifetime endeavor, and her desire to give back to her high school was unsurpassed.

We are beginning a new year with the hope of continuing to be a source of encouragement for our "Warrior Kids". In August we will meet for our annual "Backpack Buddy" packing party and potluck barbecue. You are all welcome to attend. Bring your favorite meat for the barbecue and a side dish to share, and join in the fun!

Of course with the "matching funds" program mentioned earlier, we hope each of you will add a little something extra when you renew your membership. We now total 132 members, representing alumni from the classes of 1929 through 2000, and look forward to more this year. It is my wish to meet as many of you as I can. Perhaps a good time would be at the Homecoming Game on September 30. Please try to come, support the Fallbrook Warriors, and remember: ONCE A WARRIOR, ALWAYS A WARRIOR!!!!
